The event centered around the theme "One Health – Without Borders " and featured three distinguished keynote speakers.

Pre-congress

The pre-congress workshop titled "Basic Epidemiology and Outbreak Investigations" was conducted from the 21st to 22nd of August 2023 at Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Sciences. The workshop, attended by 20 participants from Botswana and 10 from membership countries was highly successful, particularly the hands-on exercises on the second day. Professor Fosgate delivered the best workshop on outbreak investigations which was exceptionally well received.
